# Admission Policy of St Columba's NS 2025/2026 Priority Categories

**Priority Category 1:** An Applicant Student who is a member of Church of Ireland or a Protestant reformed church or is a member of a minority religion which has the same religious ethos, or a similar religious ethos to the programme of religious instruction/education which is provided in the school and who lives within the boundary of **the parish of Drumcondra**, **St Barnabas & North Strand**, **and the parish of St George and St Thomas**.

Priority Category 2: An Applicant Student who lives within the parish of Drumcondra North Strand and St Barnabas, and the parish of St George and St Thomas and who complies with the terms of this Policy.
